

# OPPOSE WYOMING SF 100

---

**SF 100 authorizes lawsuits demanding \$50,000 in damages against social media platforms that remove “viewpoints” posted by users -- even if the post is offensive, abusive, or obscene.**

**Worse, SF 100 authorizes \$50,000 lawsuits against any Wyoming citizen who flags a viewpoint that is then removed from the social media page. Examples of “viewpoints” that are protected from removal by SF 100:**

- ★ Under SF 100, if the pastor at a church flags an Atheist's hurtful comment on the Church's YouTube page, the Atheist can sue the pastor and the Church for \$50,000 if the comment is removed.
- ★ If your constituent flags Al Jazeera content celebrating acts of terrorism on a social media platform and the content is removed, Al Jazeera can sue your constituent for censoring their viewpoint, under SF 100.
- ★ Say someone posts on a public school's Facebook page demanding that schools close because children are dying from COVID, and the school district removes the post because it is against CDC guidelines. SF 100 authorizes the creator of that post to sue the school system for censoring their viewpoint, demanding \$50,000.

And a plaintiff's attorney could seek a class action for over a billion dollars, since SF 100 says anyone in Wyoming who could have seen the post can be a plaintiff.

- ★ SF 100 enables \$50,000 lawsuits against Wyoming's state committees for the Republican and Democrat parties -- if they removed opposing viewpoints posted on the pages they manage on major social media platforms.
