AMERICANS EXPRESS CONCERN OVER BIDEN'S PROGRESSIVE ANTITRUST APPROACH

A majority of Americans fear that Biden's antitrust policymaking will result in higher prices.

56% EXPRESSED LITTLE TO NO CONFIDENCE

Voters have widespread doubts that Biden is effectively protecting consumers as his regulators shift policy to punish companies based on their size instead of consumer welfare.

59% Expressed doubts

59% EXPRESSED DOUBTS

22% Expressed little or no doubts

19% Unsure

Respondents do not like that Biden is considering adopting foreign regulations in the U.S. that unfairly target American companies and industries.

A plurality would be less likely to vote for a candidate who supports regulations modeled after laws like the EU's Digital Markets Act, while

only 18%

would be more likely to back such a candidate.

The government must prioritize the welfare of American consumers, businesses, and interests—not foreign laws or progressive pundits seeking to punish our success.
